

AUTOSTART CARD
INSTRUCTIONS

The magnetic card labeled AUTOSTRT contains a special LEX file.

AUTOSTRT gives you the capability of executing a program in your HP-75 as soon as it is turned on. This will be particularly useful to you if your HP-75C will be used as a dedicated system.

Just follow these two simple steps in order to make use of the AUTOSTRT capability:

1. Read the LEX file from the AUTOSTART card into your HP-75.

COPY CARD TO "AUTOSTRT"

2. Decide which steps you wish the HP-75 to execute at turn-on.
 - a. If you want the HP-75 to only execute a BASIC program, name the program "AUTOST".
 - b. If you want the HP-75 to execute several steps, a LEX file command or plug-in ROM file, redefine character 159 by editing the KEYS file.

```
EDIT KEYS
FETCH 159
159 [steps to run at power on]
```

e.g. 159 RUN 'DATACOMM'

or

```
159 ASSIGNIO @ DISP "READY"
```

That's all there is to using "AUTOSTRT" with AUTOSTRT present within HP-75 RAM. Anytime you turn the HP-75 on by pressing [ATTN], it will execute the AUTOST program or the procedure defined for character 159 automatically.
